Competition Rules

1. This competition is open to all currently enrolled students of INTI International University and Colleges.
2. Every participant must also be enrolled as an INTI student at the point of entry submission.

4. You can also access the website via the QR Code on the Competition Poster.
5. On the competition website, click the link to fill out **the Entry Form**.
6. Follow the instructions on how to upload your Video via **WeTransfer**.
7. The deadline for entry submission is **5:00 pm (Malaysian time) on 15 October 2016**.
8. All submitted videos will become the property of INTI to be used for educational and promotional purposes.
9. Video content must evolve around the theme: **“The Future of Learning”**.
10. Video must be produced using **English as the official language**.
11. Participants may work together in **groups** (of NOT more than 5 members) or submit entries as **individuals**.
12. Any entry with more than 5 members will be disqualified.
13. Each participant is **ONLY** allowed to submit **ONE** entry.
14. **EACH** participant will receive a Certificate of Participation from INTI & Blackboard.
15. For group submission, the first name listed will be the main point of contact (Team Lead). Certificates of Participation and prizes will be given to the names submitted in the Entry form.
16. Do **NOT** use any copyrighted materials (music, images, etc.) in your video – unless you own the copyright or have a licence to use the material. Written permission must be obtained and provided upon request for all copyrighted materials. You may write your own music or use “stock” music that is included in some editing software.
17. Any proprietary information used in the video must be cited, giving credit to the original source. Plagiarism of any kind will result in disqualification.
18. Participants should keep at least one copy of their video, including their source files. The organisers are not responsible for any videos that are lost, damaged, or that could not be viewed properly.

19. Entries will be judged based on the following criteria:
 - Adherence to the theme
 - Clarity of message
 - Quality (output of sound, visual, lighting)
 - Language Accuracy
 - Creativity
20. The judges' decisions are final.
21. INTI Staff and family members do not qualify to participate in this competition.
22. Prizes are as below:
 - Grand Prize: Cash RM4,500/=
 - 1st Runner-Up: Cash RM2,000/=
 - 2nd Runner-Up: Cash RM1,000/=
 - Consolation Prizes: Cash RM200/= X 10
23. Certificate of Participation will be awarded to each participant whose video has met the minimum requirements and guidelines of this competition.
